2022 Honored Clan CLAN MACFARLANE

The MacFarlanes occupied the land forming the western shore of Loch Lomond. From Loch Sloy, a small sheet of water at the foot of Ben Vorlich, they tool their war cry of Loch Slòigh.



The clan was noted for the nighttime cattle raiding of neighboring clan lands and, as such, a full moon became known locally as "MacFarlane's Lantern".

The clan lands were held by the chiefs until they were sold off for debts in 1767. Since 1866 the chiefship has been dormant with no one having claimed or obtained matriculation of the Chief Arms.
